This may be a handy newsletter to keep by your telephone – especially for all our new residents! It contains phone numbers and information as to who to contact for help with specific issues in your neighbourhood.

911 is of course, the **EMERGENCY NUMBER** that you should call for fire, medical emergencies or for threatening safety issues. The 911 call operator will connect you to police, fire or ambulance as required and offer verbal contact until help arrives.

1-888-310-1122 is the **OPP DISPATCH OFFICE** (the OPP service Port Franks). You could call this number for any matters in which you may need non emergency police assistance such as vandalism.

1-800-222-8477 is the **CRIME STOPPERS** number and is used for such things as reporting criminal activity that you may have witnessed.

519-786-2335 is **LAMBTON SHORES' Municipal Office** which is located in Forest. Any municipal matter can be addressed at this number. Mayor Gord Minielly can be reached at this number.

519-243-1400 is your Northville **LAMBTON SHORES' Community Services** office. Information on topics such as snow removal, leaf pick up and road maintenance is available here.

519-381-9899 is the cell number for our **BY- LAW OFFICER, Glenn Bell**. He can be contacted anonymously for such things as barking dogs, noise problems, unsafe use of fireworks and other infractions of the by-laws for Port Franks. Copies of the by-laws are available at the municipal office in Forest. In future newsletters we will expand on some of these by-laws that have been put in place by our elected representatives.

519-243-3034 is your elected **COUNCILLOR, Mark Simpson's** phone number. Mark represents Ward 3, Lambton Shores. Call Mark to discuss issues such as taxation or facilities improvement.
