We have been trying to contact you for some time. You are receiving this Newsletter in the mail because we have recently manually retrieved your address from the Lambton Shores Tax Roll. We want to let you know about our organization and our plan for a valuable new service for you.

The Port Franks Community Police Committee is a group of Port Franks landowners/residents who meet monthly to maintain a liaison between the OPP and the Port Franks community. We identify community and individual concerns and, with the help of the OPP, effect solutions. We also work to encourage a sense of pride and a commitment to improve the quality of life in our community. All residents of Port Franks are welcome to join or to present any neighbourhood concerns at one of our meetings. We meet on the second Tuesday of each month from March to December at the Optimist's Community Centre.

Several times each year we publish our Newsletter, similar to this communication. We have included a recent issue as an example for you. In these newsletters we provide valuable information about your community. They are distributed through Canada Post. As you do not receive your mail here in Port Franks we miss the opportunity to reach out to you as we do the local residents*.

This year we are introducing a valuable new service for you, the non resident landowner.

We will "Keep an Eye" on your property year round for you! One of our members will occasionally drive by your property and note any abnormalities visible from the street. We will do this at least once per month and contact you should anything look suspicious or out of order. If you would like we can contact the OPP as well, should the situation warrant it.

We feel this service can be of value to you in this hectic world in which you cannot always make it up to the Port to check out your property when you might like. This service is available to you for a \$15.00 per year donation to our committee, and by returning the enclosed information sheet with your cheque made out to Port Franks Community Police Committee.
